

Shepherd of the Valley MOPS Scholarship Program

Purpose:

The confidential scholarship program at SOTV MOPS is designed to assist those Moms who cannot meet the total cost of attending SOTV MOPS.

Eligibility:

SOTV MOPS does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in the administration of its admissions policies, educational policies, or scholarship/aid programs.

Source of Funds:

The SOTV MOPS Steering Team designates the amount of funding available annually to provide financial assistance for SOTV MOPS Moms.

Total financial assistance awarded for a SOTV MOPS Semester cannot exceed the budgeted amounts. If situations arise where additional awards are considered necessary, the funding for these additional awards must be obtained prior to the actual granting of the financial assistance.

Application for Scholarship:

Moms wishing to be considered for confidential scholarship monies at SOTV MOPS must complete a request for financial assistance.

There is one type of assistance offered:

1. General assistance – used for partial scholarship for the SOTV MOPS semester. (The maximum amount granted is typically $\frac{1}{2}$ of the tuition, however, special need situations will be considered.)

Applications can be obtained from the coordinator and should be completed and returned to the coordinator.

The Coordinator and the Finance Team Leader will review and approve or deny all applications. General assistance scholarships are only valid for 1 semester and must be re-applied for, for additional semesters.

The scholarship program is designed to provide assistance to as many families as possible with the limited resources available.

The scholarship program will require some form of Mom contribution in connection with financial assistance.
