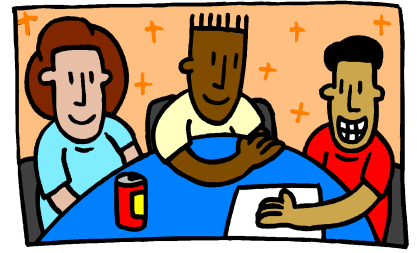


We need YOU as a High School Leader!

[] **Facilitator for 9th Grade Confirmation** (work with 9th grade small groups—must be in 11th-12th gr.)
Commitment: Wednesdays 6:30-8pm for pizza, check-in, and confirmation; mandatory trainings 2-3/year

[] **Small Group Leader for 8th Grade Confirmation** (attend large group, lead discussions in small group)
Circle Preferred Wednesday Session Time: 4:30 5:45 7:00
Commitment: Wednesdays for one hour, 2 HYPE Sundays each year, and training

[] **Small Group Leader for 6th/7th Grade Confirmation** (attend large group, lead small group disc)
Circle Preferred Wednesday Session Time: 3:15 4:30 5:45 7:00
Commitment: Wednesdays for one hour, 2 HYPE Sundays each year, and training

[] **Working one-on-one w/ a student with special needs** (modified God Zone or confirmation)

Commitment: regular attendance at rehearsals and gigs once or twice each month

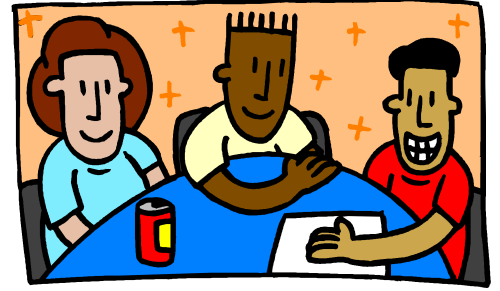
