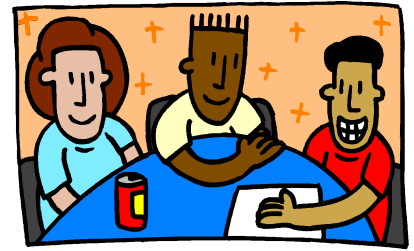


# We need YOU as a High School Leader!

**Facilitator for 9th Grade Confirmation** (work with 9th grade small groups—must be in 10th-12th gr.)  
*Commitment: Wednesdays 6:30-8pm for pizza, check-in, and confirmation; mandatory trainings 2-3/year*

**Small Group Leader for 8th Grade Confirmation** (attend large group, lead discussions in small group)  
Circle Preferred Wednesday Session Time: 3:15 5:45 7:00  
*Commitment: Wednesdays for 1 hour+, 2 HYPE Sundays each year, and training*

**Small Group Leader for 6th/7th Grade Confirmation** (attend large group, lead small group disc)  
Circle Preferred Wednesday Session Time: 3:15 4:30 5:45 7:00  
*Commitment: Wednesdays for 1 hour+, 2 HYPE Sundays each year, and training*

**Working one-on-one w/ a student with special needs** (in God Zone or confirmation)

*Commitment: will depend on the particular student and situation*

*Commitment: Sun, Mon, or Wed for one hour, class preparation each week, and fall training session*

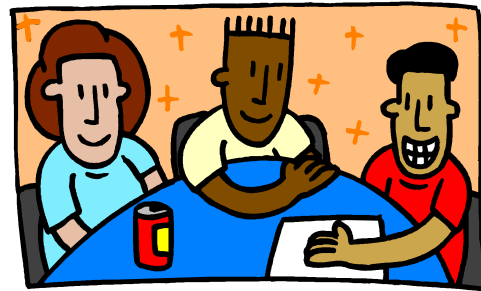
**Help with worship on Saturday Night or Sunday Morning**
