

MIDDLE SCHOOL EVENTS

At least one night each month middle school students arrive in droves to participate in a fun activity! These events are the perfect time to hang out with friends from confirmation, meet new people, or invite kids you know from school. Some events will be service, some will be social, all will be fun! Register on a form found in the Youth/Children's Ministry office and the Welcome Center or sign up for each event online at SOTV.org

- **Run Ragged 'til Midnight** is our biggest middle school event of the year! Come to church and find fun everywhere you turn: bounce around on giant inflatables, play popular video games, get a makeover at the hair and nail salon, Dance, Dance, Revolution until you drop, rap with Agape, and so much more. The event is on October 23 from 7-midnight and the cost is \$30. Registration is limited to 150 participants.
- On November 13 from 7-10 PM come join us for **Friday Night Service at Feed My Starving Children**. Last year, 5.8 million meals were packaged by young volunteers, just like you. These meals were shipped to hungry children around the world. Registration is limited to 40 youth and the cost is \$5.
- **Generation Change: Financial Peace for Teens** is on **Thursdays, October 29, November 5, 12, & 19 from 7:00-9:00 PM**. Do you wonder whether you will ever have enough "stuff"? Is money ever a touchy subject in your family? Consider taking time to reflect on your finances from both a faith perspective and a practical perspective using videos, Bible study, and a personal journal to learn valuable skills and good habits that will last you a lifetime. The cost is \$20.
- **Boys Basketball Teams** - Do you like to play basketball, but don't have time for lots of practices? If that sounds like you, SOTV sponsors several teams in the Augsburg College Youth Basketball league - no practices, with games on Sunday afternoons in various locations in the Twin Cities. Please look for more information this fall. We need parent coaches also! The cost is \$35.
- **Movie & Game Night** - On December 11 from 7-10 PM, we will dig the games out of the closet - if you have some favorites please bring them along - and we will set up some short seasonal movies to get you in the holiday spirit. The cost is \$5. Registration is limited to 100 participants.
- **Tubefest 2010** is on January 8 from 6:30-10 PM. Meet at SOTV, hop on the bus, and then head to the icy tubing hill at Afton Alps. Leave room for hot chocolate in the lodge. We are limited to the first 60 tubers. The cost is \$20! Registration deadline is Wednesday, January 3.
- **Justice for All: Youth Homelessness** is January 10. There are over 250 homeless people in Dakota County and half of them are under the age of 21. Please bring a sack lunch to eat together. Then from 12:30-3PM, participate in many interactive sessions led by local professionals about homelessness in our area, the effects stable housing has on young people, participate in a poverty simulation, learn how you can help, prepare sandwiches for homeless people, pray together, and much more! Students are encouraged to attend with a parent or caring adult. Cost is \$5 to be donated to local service agencies and registration deadline is January 3. (This may be a HYPE event for some 7th & 8th grade small groups, in that case, registration is not necessary.)

- **Welch Village Ski Trip - A SOTV TRADITION!** Welch Village is the place to be from January 22-24. Get lodging in a cabin at the bottom of the hill, transportation, meals and lift tickets for \$205 with ski/board rental, \$155 if you have your own gear, or \$100 if you have your own gear and a Welch season pass. Welch Village is limited to 25 girls and 25 boys. A \$75 deposit will hold your spot
- On February 19 from 7:00-10:00 PM come join us for **Friday Night Service at Feed My Starving Children**. Registration is limited to 40 youth. Cost is \$5.
- Middle School March Mondays is lots of fun, fun, fun! Please join us Mondays in March for an after school snack, fellowship, study, and some fun. The cost is \$10. (We will not meet on March 22.)
- Here's your chance to stay up all night!!! That's right all night this time and it is called **Moonlight Madness!** Board the bus at 9 PM on Friday, March 12 to head to Dakotah! Health and Fitness where we will have access to ice rink, pool, rock climbing, gym, bowling alley, and all of the other fun stuff that is there. We will return at 7AM on Saturday. The cost for Moonlight Madness is \$40 and includes the fees for skate rental, rock climbing and bowling. Registrations are due by Wednesday, March 10 and is limited to 120 participants. - April 16 from 7-10 PM is your last chance for the year to join us for **Feed My Starving Children**. Registration is limited to 40 youth. Cost is \$5.
