Week 1: Live Fully - Even in the Desert

READ THE STORY: Luke 4:1-13, Jesus in the desert (page 248 in the Spark Story Bible).

WONDER:

- Have you ever been tempted to make a bad choice? How did it feel?
- What choice do you think was hardest for Jesus to make? (*Refusing to turn a stone into bread, turning down power over all the kingdoms, or saying no to the devil's dare?*)
- Jesus used the bible to help make choices in this story. What other things help you know if a choice is a good or bad one?
- Who or what can help you make choices that honor God, honor other people, and honor yourself?
