
Palm Sunday: Even the Stones Cry Out

WONDER:

- Why do you think the religious leaders wanted the parade to stop?
- What do you think Jesus meant when he said the stones would shout out?
- Have you ever felt like someone wanted you to stay quiet instead of telling the truth?
