<u>Call to Order</u>: President Melissa Taphorn called the meeting to order at 6:33 PM. Rachel Wermerskirchen shared an opening prayer.

Book Study: Pastor Lindsey Bina guided the council through a discussion of Chapter 3 of the book *Growing Young: Six Essential Strategies to Help Young People Discover and Love Your Church.* Council will discuss chapter 4 in February.

<u>Vision and Leadership Teams Reports</u>: Jennifer Davidson shared an update on columbarium (10 niches to hit next milestone) and leadership position vacancies upcoming. <u>Finance Report</u>: Dick Rank provided an overview of the December financials. December was a good month, better than budget. Actual to Prior Year is very close. Forecasting to be down in January and February. Will review additional mortgage payment in January (end of quarter). Finance did not have a quorum, will approve financials in February.

Jennifer Davidson reviewed the Corporate Signature Resolution, removing Pastor Rick Summy, adding Pastor Julie Wright. Jon Hohenstein moved to approve the Corporate Signature Resolution. Bernie Zimmermann seconded the motion, and the council voted unanimously, 10-0, to approve the Corporate Signature Resolution.

Jennifer Davidson read the housing allowance for called leader for allocation. Paul Moyer moved to approve the housing allowance. Shirl Alojado seconded the motion, and the council voted unanimously, 10-0, to approve the annual housing allowance.

Nominations: Merilu Narum shared her team would be happy to review applications and open leadership team positions.

<u>New Business</u>: Jennifer Davidson shared about fundraiser for Tanzania. Set to take place last weekend in January during Tanzania worship with fundraising effort for lab and final furnishings of lab – goal is \$5-7K. Jon Hohenstein moved to approve the fundraiser at Tanzania worship weekend. Melissa Taphorn seconded the motion and the council voted unanimously, 10-0, to approve the fundraiser at Tanzania worship weekend.

Jennifer Davidson shared Mark Ertl will be taking a sabbatical. 12 week leave within timeframe of May-August. Organ project will be starting after Easter, Mark will need to be available. Subs and musicians are available the during time. Sabbatical was approved by Pastor Rick Summy and HR Leadership Team. Shirl Alojado moved to approve Mark Ertl's sabbatical. Bernie Zimmermann seconded the motion and the council voted unanimously, 10-0, to approve Mark Ertl's sabbatical.

Pastor Lindsey Bina asked for feedback and discussion regarding Saturday summer evening worship. This has been a topic of conversation since 2019. There are staffing, soloist, cost and attendance considerations. One of few churches in the area that offer Saturday night service. Options to experiment with not having worship Saturday night Memorial Day – Labor Day. Not looking to make permanent changes and decide before April. Is it all or nothing? Every other week (keep communion weekends)? Saturday worship is already as scaled back as it can for it still to be meaningful. Conversation was split, save the money vs. worshipers are children of God and have meaningful connections to the church.

<u>Adjourn</u>: Bernie Zimmermann moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:12 PM. Dick Rank seconded the motion and the council voted unanimously, 10-0, to approve the motion to adjourn.

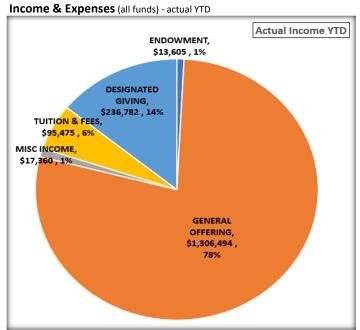

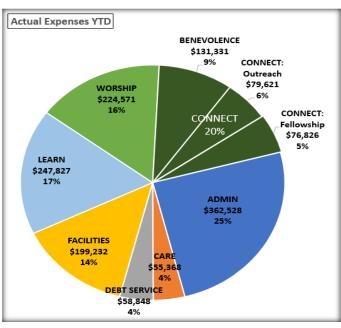
